Steve (Mr Submarine Man) who was a Shepton Mallet Drifter and member of AMS (Association Of Model Submariners) was well known and liked amongst the model boating fraternity. He never tired of explaining to the public and other modellers the black art of how a submarine works. Steve never worried about where he sailed his subs and watching him launch like the OMRA guys by almost chucking the sub in the water was something else. I wonder how many among you remember him sailing a yacht at Plymouth a few years ago, a very rare sight.

Steve built quality models and was an award winner at many National/Major shows; he also appeared on TV including Blue Peter and got a badge! His 2 man submarine was one of his last major projects and he spent ages acquiring all sorts of rubber gloves so as to make the diving suits on the men as realistic as possible. He claimed it was not a perfect scale example however he noticed a difference in the stern and built a complete replacement end. He was a perfectionist, an engineer and always ready to help, he once made me a mast in various pieces and by the time I got it home I had lost part of it. Sheepishly I went back and told him and he built me another of course I was reminded of it on several occasions he had a good sense of humour and enjoyed jokes. I shall miss him he was a good friend and our condolences go to Diana and his sons Nigel and Graham and their families.

# Minutes of the 14<sup>th</sup> AGM of the SHEPTON MALLET DRIFTERS M.B.C.

The Chairman paid tribute to club member Stephen Webb who passed away and a minute's silence took place in his memory. The Chairman welcomed all members present and thanked them for their support at the meeting

**Apologies:** M.Knight, P & I Rodda, R. Stevens. A card was read from Pam Rodda with apologies as Ivan has been in hospital but was now recovering at home.

**Minutes:** Minutes of the last AGM were read, approved and signed by the Chairman.

**Matters Arising:** Chairman reported that a card had been sent to Ivan on behalf of Club Members.

Child Protection Act. A meeting had been held at Mendip District Council Offices with an in depth presentation by Alan Chinn, known to many modellers who works for the Avon and Somerset Constabulary.. The presentation had been set up in Somerset on **Child Safe**. This was attended by the Chairman and Secretary. The law states that a policy needs to be in place in the club for the protection of children and vulnerable adults.

After much discussion, it was agreed that the Club needs a policy in place with regards to Child protection including family members. In reality the club has a very low percentage of children. Danny Harris asked how it would affect children at the lakeside. for example to 'Have a Go'

The Chairman said that two adults are needed at all times when dealing with children. Ted Porter asked how it would affect junior membership and suggested that we keep membership as it is for the time until the policy is in place.i.e. not having an individual junior membership. A vote followed that membership should be kept as it is until the policy is in place, which will be approved by Somerset County Council. Once the policy is in place junior membership may begin. Junior membership ends at age 18. Proposed. Rob Trott Seconded Stuart Bell. A vote followed, there were 19 for, 5 against with 2 abstentions. Motion was carried. There will not be a full CRB check.

**Chairman's report:** There were good results on competitions. Good reports on Table top display which was built and rebuilt. There was on going problems with weed at Collett Park. Chairman thanked Verd for looking after finances. Colin for secretarial work. Ted for the Newsletter. Maggie for dealing with photographs on the web site. Thanks for everyone who supported events.

**Treasure's report:** Membership included family membership is now at 76. There are still 10 left of the original 93 members. Very successful financial year with almost £300 up on last year. Main cost £280 Insurance, Postage £51. There will be no increase in membership fees..

Thanks were extended to all members who paid promptly. Balance sheets were distributed. Danny Harris proposed that accounts were accepted Nigel Harvey seconded unanimous approval by members.

**Secretary's Report:** Colin wished everyone a Happy New year and thanked everyone for support. He invited anyone else to take over the role as secretary. Chairman thanked Colin for his work.

**NewsLetter report:** Driftwood has been successfully published for another year. There have been extracts from SWAMBC. Minutes of club meetings as well as future events. Weymouth Members should have received registration forms or they can be downloaded from SWAMBC Web site. Registrations are already over 100 so far.

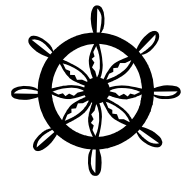
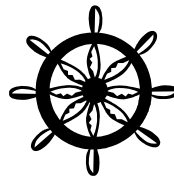
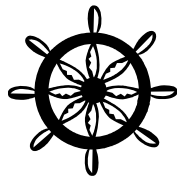
## A.O.B
